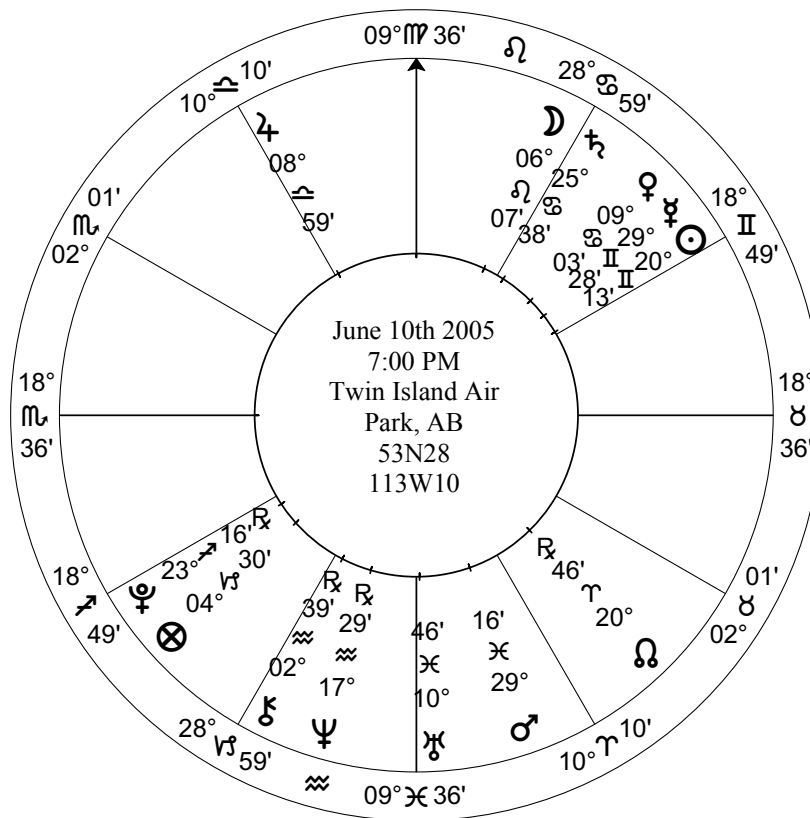

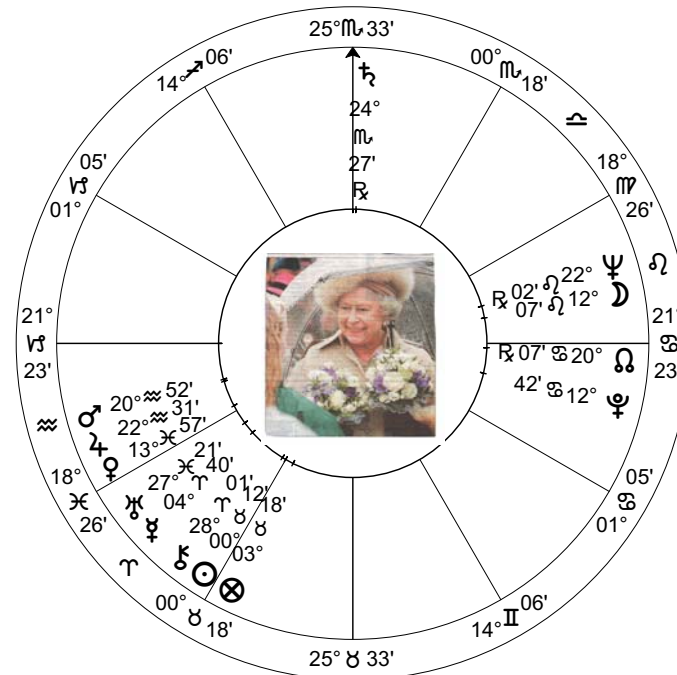

The inner planet cycles are intrinsically linked to our every day lives—our money, activities and routines. The personal planets have lost their rightful place as significant timers and instigators of change. Mercury spends up six months in an element in a year, Venus spends four months in a sign at 18-month intervals, and at two-year intervals Mars stops to play in one sign for up to six months! This year the emphasis is on fire and earth—finding inspiration and doing the work to realize our ideations.

These cycles allow us to predict our year with fascinating precision, and help understand the ebb and flow of the rhythm of life. Particular focus will be given to the precise cycle of Venus, by simply knowing the predictable dates, we can begin to understand her cycle of change—thus 'when' and 'what'.

The travel plans and aspect patterns of the inner planets offer a wealth of information about your future. Mercury ensures that we take care of business as he travels through the houses in sets based on the element-life, substance, relationships and endings.

## Paul Hewitt

### Paul Hewitt

Here is Paul Hewitt's Curriculum Vitae, or Bio, in his own words:

My working life started in the 1970's. In those days I worked as an All-Risk Insurance Underwriter for Fireman's Fund of Canada. Eventually I ended up working in the Company's head office in Toronto doing insurance underwriting and staff training. For twenty years I also enjoyed performing as a singer-songwriter all over Ontario. During this time I was also intently studying astrology. I began to see clients in 1980 after a decade of studying. I taught astrology classes in Toronto, Ontario from 1980 until 1996. During that time I also lectured on astrology at conferences in New York (an NCGR regional), Montreal, Winnipeg, Toronto, Cleveland (W.R.A.C.), St. Catharines, Hartford (A.S.C.), and Vancouver. In addition to lecturing at conferences, I was also a featured speaker in Toronto, London, Waterloo, Ottawa, Edmonton, Winnipeg, Philadelphia and Calgary, and the keynote speaker at conferences in Montreal (1987), Cleveland (1991) and in Toronto (1995).

Together with Priscilla Costello and Cicely Flanagan, I helped to run FCA Toronto (a local affiliate of the national Fraternity for Canadian Astrologers) for almost a decade in the 1980's as a volunteer. Once a month we would host an American or Canadian astrologer who would present a different astrology topic and keep us up to date with the latest ideas happening in astrology around the continent. We also hosted conferences in Toronto. For our first conference we invited Doris Hebel from Chicago and had 110 attendees from all over eastern North America. To have astrologers in Toronto from as far away as Kansas City was quite affirming! Our largest monthly turnout that decade was 95 people for Rob Hand.

During this time period, I was also the Managing Editor of the Fraternity News (the FCA's national astrology journal) from 1982 to 1984. For almost 7 years I also edited, contributed articles to, and published RAMC, a quarterly magazine on computer program-



ming for astrologers getting into computers.

At the FCA Vancouver conference in 1985, I was elected the national President of the FCA and served in that position for 2 years. Our proudest accomplishment during that time was hosting Canada's first bilingual conference in Montreal, Quebec with simultaneous translation of most speakers from English to French and vice-versa. We invited well-known author A.T.Mann from Europe to speak and had over 200 attendees.

In 1985, I was awarded the FCA Uranus award for "Progressive, original and resourceful inventiveness, expanding astrological parameters". In 1987, I was also awarded the FCA Mars award for "A dynamic and pioneering spirit contributing to the progress and growth of astrology".

In the 1980's, I became seriously interested in using astrology to do career counseling. Through my company, Heron and Hawk Careers, I launched my first computer program in 1986, known as the "the Career Report". The software is still used today by mail-order astrology services advertising in the Mountain Astrologer. During the late 1980's to the mid 1990's, I was invited many times to lecture as a career counselor at NATCON in Ottawa (the National Consultation On Vocational Counseling, Canada's national conference for career counselors). In 1995, I was certified to use the Strong Interest Inventory, a career-counseling questionnaire used for career counseling. The "Strong" was developed at Stanford University.

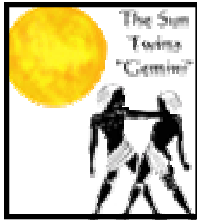
I continue to work as a professional astrologer and career counselor in Calgary, Alberta. My clients now call me from all over North America. I also continue to teach astrology classes in Calgary and still really enjoy lecturing on this wonderful and incredibly insightful subject!

### Lecture Topic: Transiting Declination

Many astrologers ignore natal planets in aspect by declination. One way to prove just how powerful these aspects really are is to test them by transit. Please bring your own chart with a list of the your natal planets by declination, to the workshop. We will cover where the major planets have been by declination over the past 20 years, and see where they will be over the next 10 years as well. Paul will quickly see when you have had transiting aspects to your natal planets by transiting declination and will discuss them with you during this workshop. Having used this technique with his clients for over 20 years now he will not
