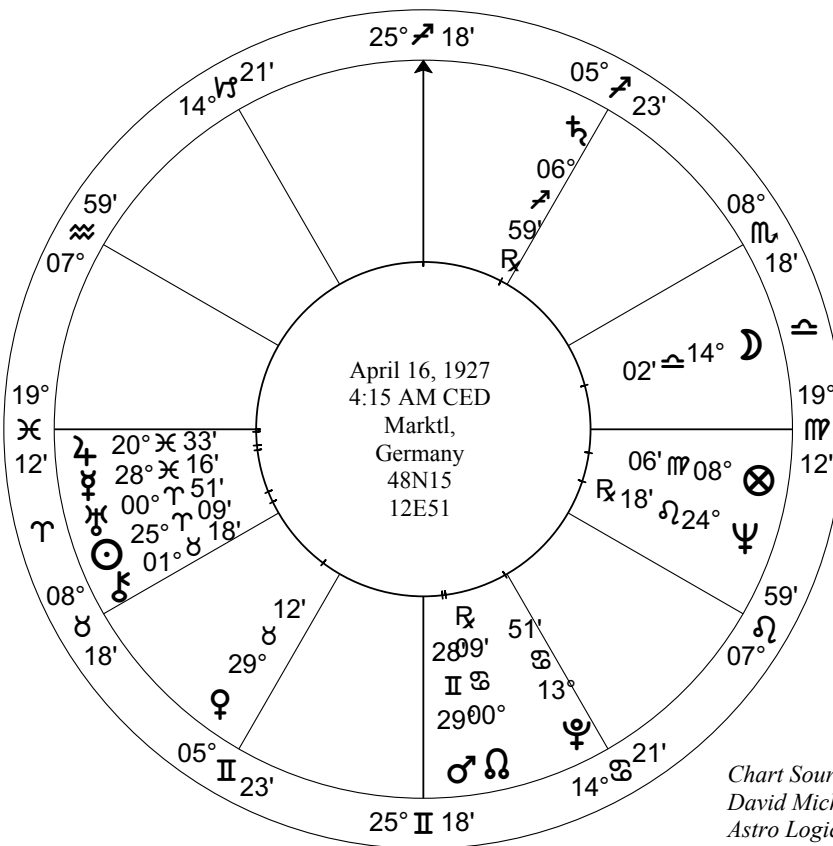

Moon's Declination Curve !

Workshop Review

Inge gave a stunning workshop of how the flow of the Moon's energy works on a timeline showing the peaks and valleys of our Life's journey.

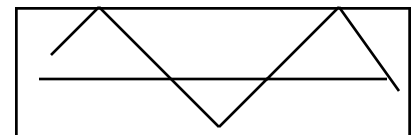
We take the declination of the Moon at birth and place the degree of declination as the starting point of the journey. The centre line of the graph is the equator. The Moon's declinations follow a cyclical path of approximately 7 years moving

from North from the equator to its highest declination and then back to the equator at 00 degrees declination and down to its farthest declination and then back up to 00 and so on. The starting point is the declination of the Moon at birth, either North or South.

Putting years on the graph at the 00 plus or minus 27 degrees was most informative.

Inge used her Moon Curve graph to show some of the turning points in her life that she has dealt with so far.

Great job Inge, we continue to learn more and more each day.

- A silent auction will be held again at the retreat, items donated by members.

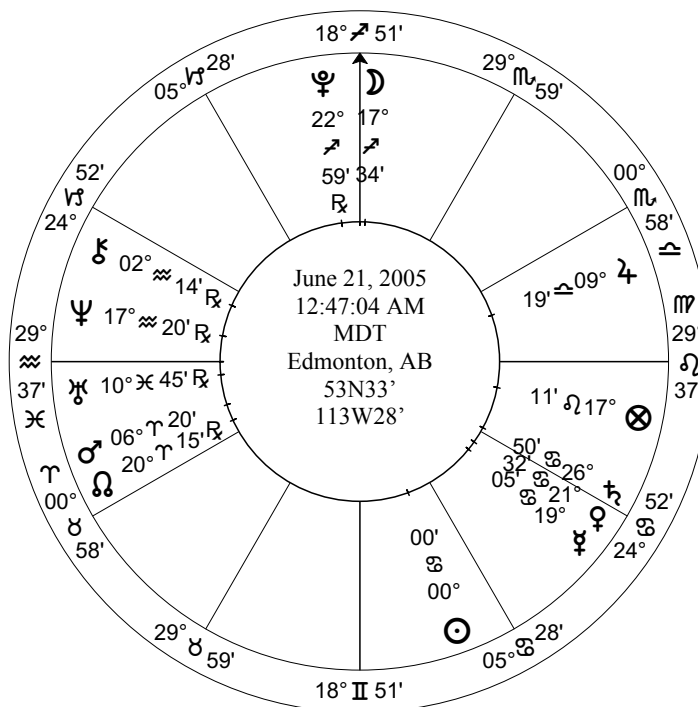
Current Events: The current events section examined Pope John Paul II's birth chart, and progressions and transits at the time of his death.

This chart has a lot of aspects, good and bad. A grand trine Pluto/Moon, North Node of the Moon and Fortuna, a T-square Mercury and the Nodes, a sextile Neptune and North Node, opposition Mars Jupiter. Take your pick. Ingress Sun in the 4th our resources are huge but because the Sun is critical there will be problems with our neighbor. Mercury ruling the 4th shows a double-bodied sign so that we have 2 different sources of wealth.

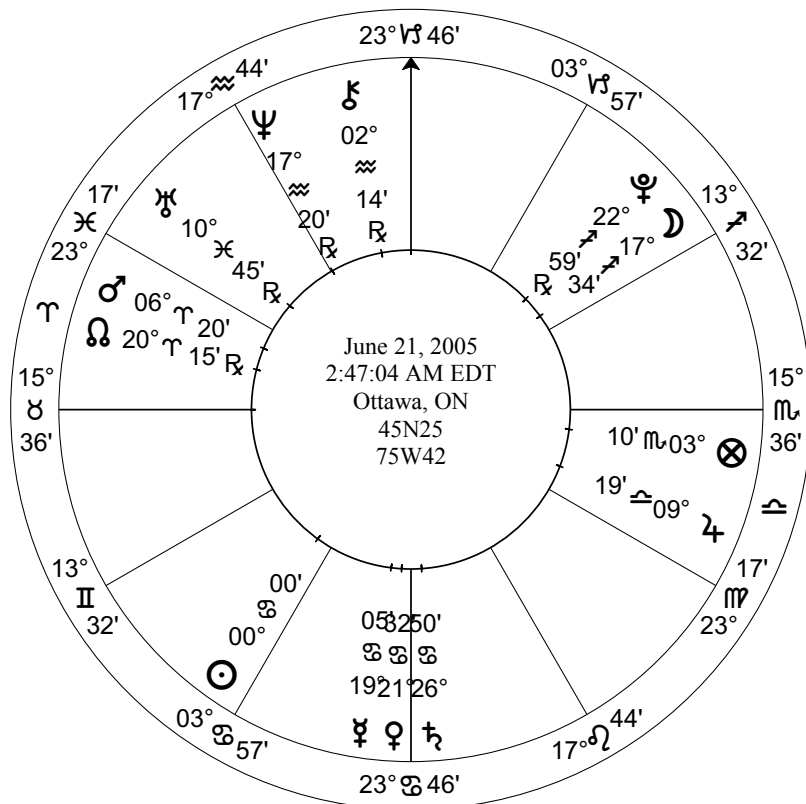
Houses 1,3,7 & 9 are all in 29 degrees, the end of the rope. Houses 2 & 8th in 0 degrees shows a new beginning. Pluto in the 10th shows the strength of the government in power. Critical Saturn in the 6th ruling the 12th another problem with health, police perhaps, but there is also Fortuna ruled by the Sun.

Perhaps the government pumps more money into these areas. The 3rd house, of media, communications, P.O. and telephone in 29 Taurus there is something to weep about in these areas. The Moon ruler of the 5th and 6th houses is in the 9th in critical degree but trine & sextile the Nodes. Nodal Chart

This concept is something I have read in a wonderfully written book called "Astrology Nutrition & Health" by Robert Carl Jansky. A technique that was used by Astrologers was to place a planet that was being studied on the Ascendant by longitude degree and minutes set up an equal house system and fill in all of the Natal planets. From this concept Robert Jansky used the premise that the South Node is the weakest part of the chart as it shows where we have come from, and old patterns and conditioning from the past. The North Node is the arrow pointing to the future.

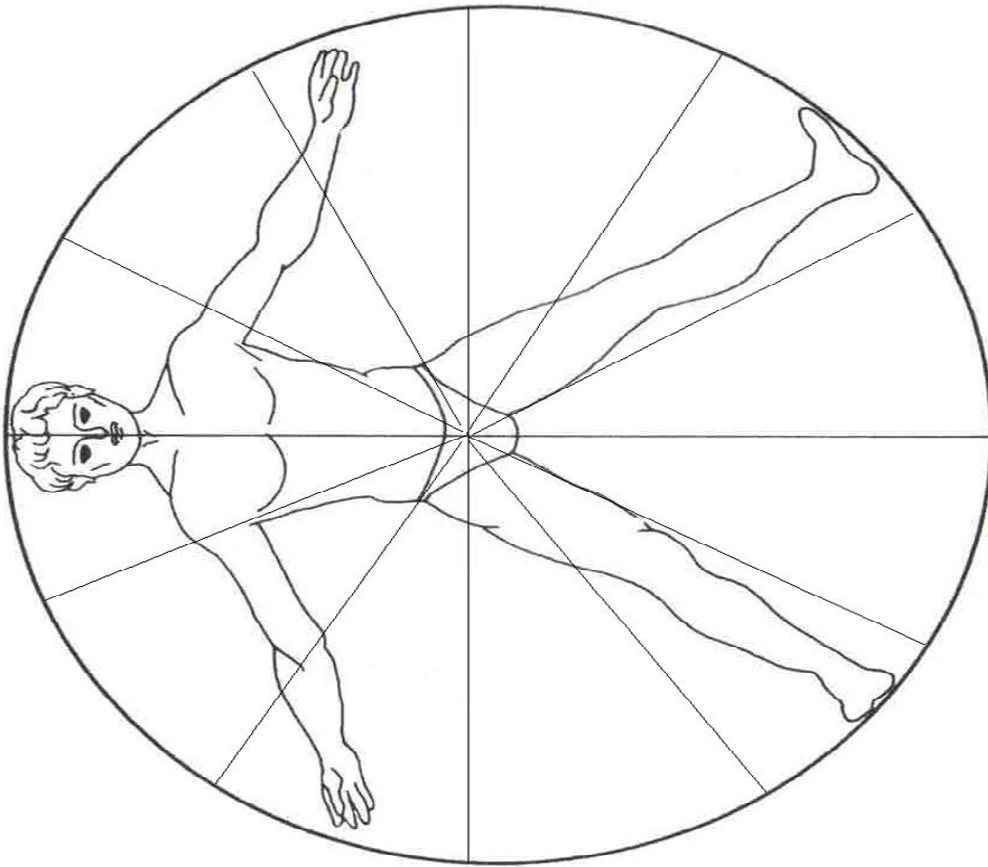
To construct the placement of the body and see the anatomical placement of the body to the houses, Robert Jansky reasoned that at birth, the head is the first part to emerge and form an independent relationship with the environment. The head is also the weakest part of the body as it is not fully closed on the crown until many days

after birth. Therefore the head would be placed on the first house of the Nodal chart as if the body were lying face up on a wheel. To determine right and left sides of the body, Robert Jansky stated that in Astrology the first 6 houses represent the personal side of one's nature, while the last 6 houses represented one's exposure to the external world. He has given rulership of the right side to the Sun, as it naturally rules the 5th house, and the left side of the body to the Moon as the ruler of the flow of energy within the body.

The form on page 5 is quite revealing of your everyday health and nutritional needs. We will fill in the Nodal Chart form and have an open discussion on how the daily transits and progressions effect the well being ness our bodies.

Nodal Chart Form



Nodal Chart

Ascendant = South Node by degree and minute, houses 1 to 6 right side of body, 7 to 12 left side.

1. Houses 12 and 1 represent the head and neck with the 2nd and 12th house cusps falling along the axis of the collarbone.
2. Houses 2 and 11 represent everything in the chest cavity from the collarbone to the diaphragm, including the heart, with the 3rd and 11th house cusps falling along the axis of the diaphragm.
3. Houses 3 and 10 represent the stomach, upper small intestine, liver, spleen and pancreas, extending down to an imaginary line through the kundalini point just below the navel.
4. Houses 4 and 9 represent the lower abdomen, rectum, kidneys, bladder, large intestine and organs of reproduction, as well as the hips.
5. Houses 5 and 8 represent the buttocks and upper legs, extending down to the middle of the kneecap.
6. Houses 6 and 7 represent the lower legs and feet.

Planets rulership of the anatomy is as follows:

Sun = Heart and circulatory system

Moon = Fluids, mucous membranes, stomach storage organs and bladder

Mercury = Nervous and respiratory systems

Venus = Throat, thyroid gland

Mars = Muscles, adrenal glands, blood

Jupiter = Liver, pancreas

Saturn = Skeletal system, teeth, bones, joints
skin, gall bladder

Uranus = Nervous system, along with Mercury

Pluto = Bowels, reproductive system
