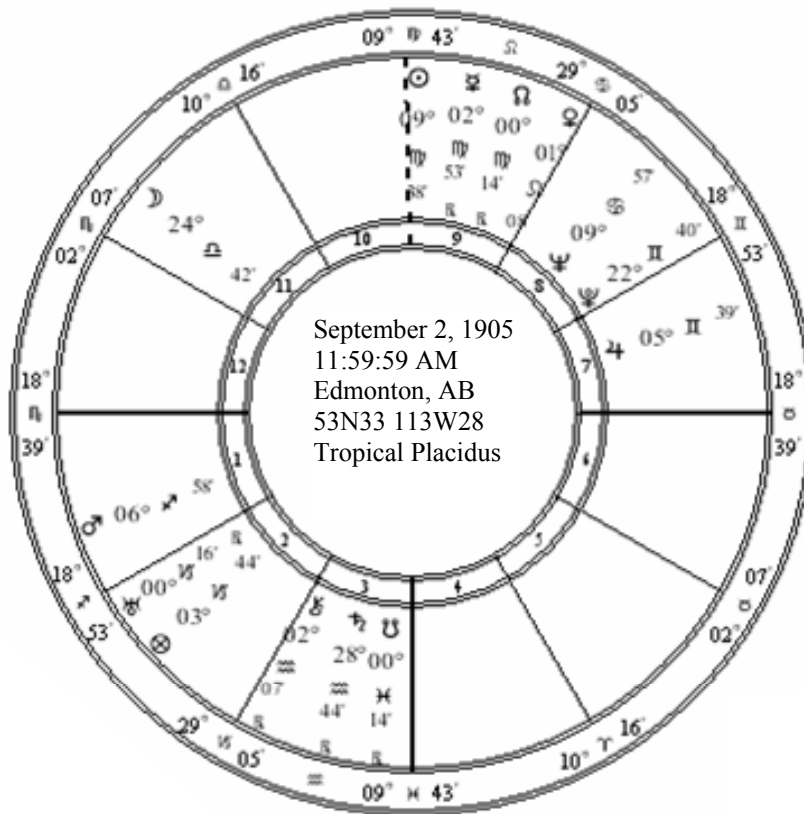

Happy 100th Birthday Alberta



On September 2nd 1905 Alexander Rutherford was appointed Premier of Alberta. The first legislature was in session on Mar 15th, 2006 and the first order of business was to select a Capital City. Edmonton was selected as the Capital City as it was the business hub of the province in 1906. The

above chart set for Noon, shows Scorpio rising with Mars in Sag in the first house. Is it any wonder that Alberta has such a reputation for "Shooting off the Mouth". Mars is disposed by Jupiter in Gemini in the 7th house, this puts Jupiter in it's detriment. We may be viewed as Red Necks but the ruler of this chart is

Mercury in Virgo in the 10th. We really are conservative. Try as we may, with Uranus in Capricorn in the second house, disposed by Saturn in Aquarius intercepted in the 3rd, we give good lip service to rebellion but we just do not have what it takes to follow through.

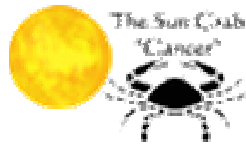
That leaves 3 classes for January that will be scheduled according to everyone's convenience.
